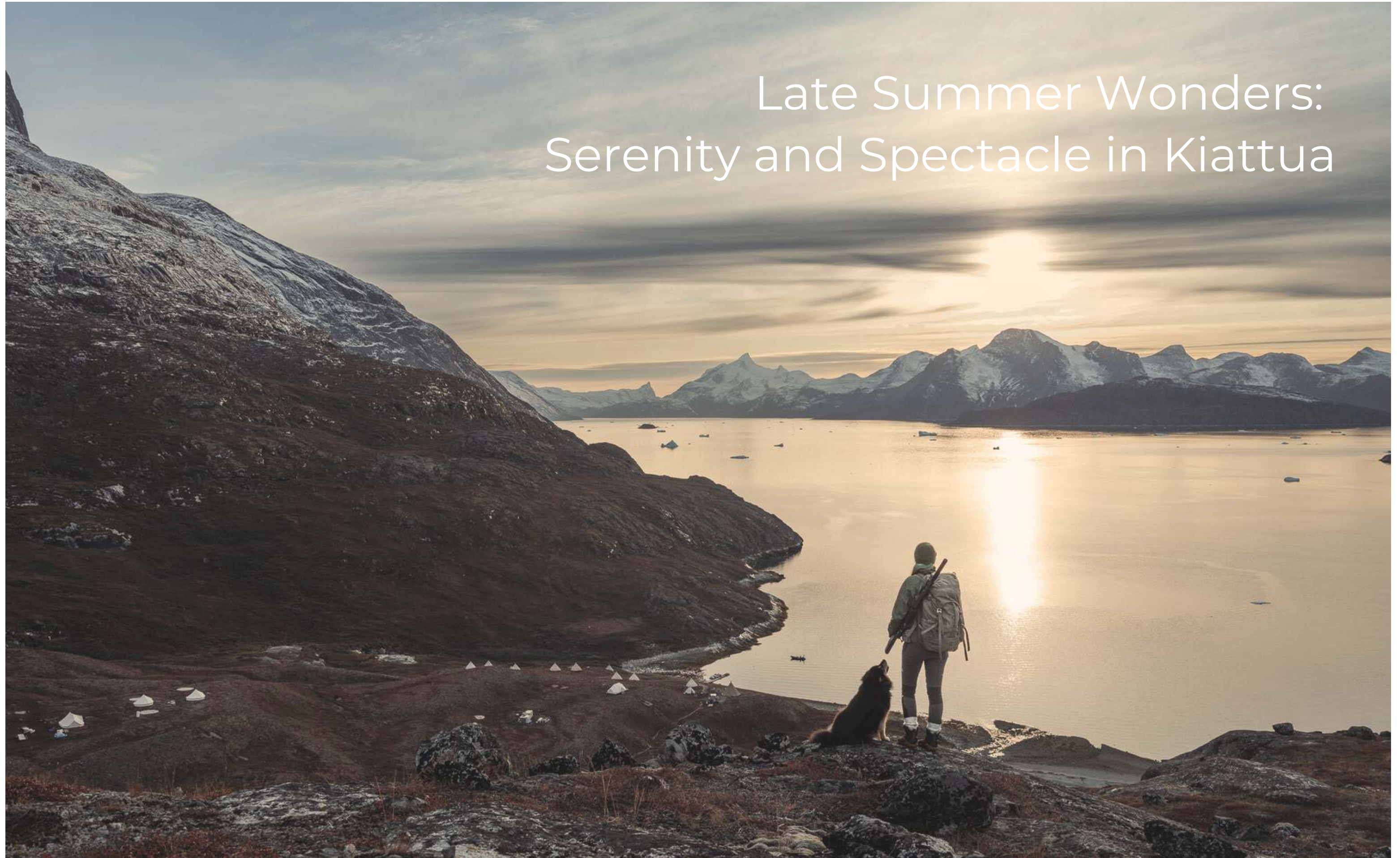
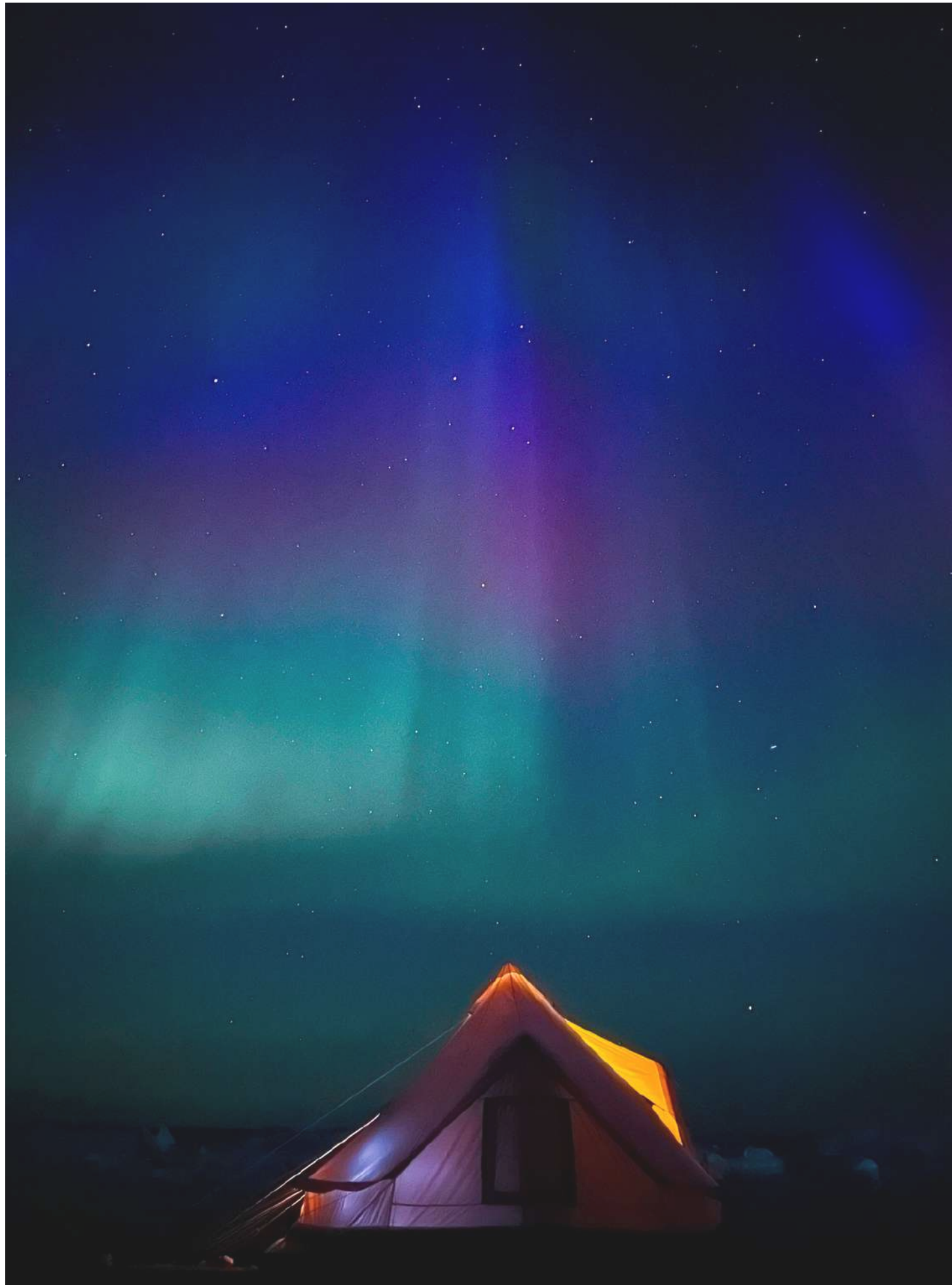


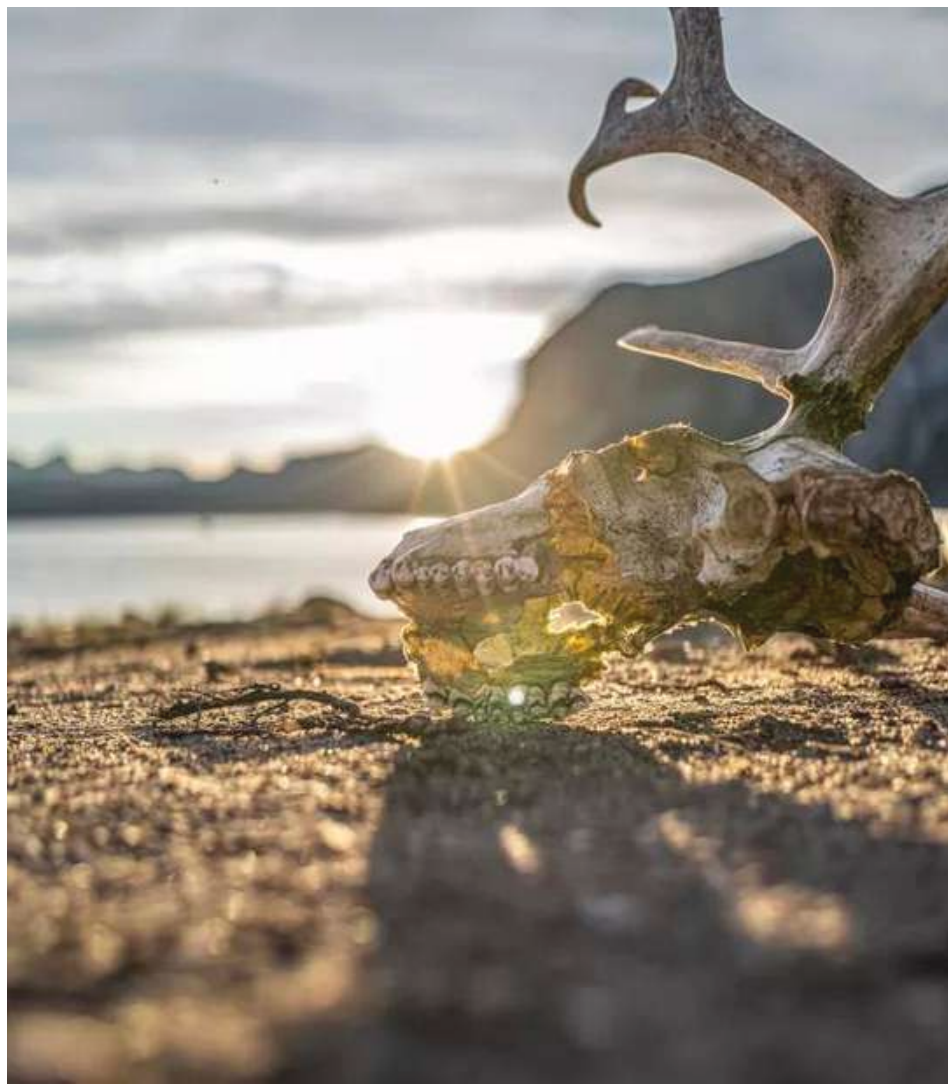
Late Summer Wonders: Serenity and Spectacle in Kiattua

- Bonfire & drinks

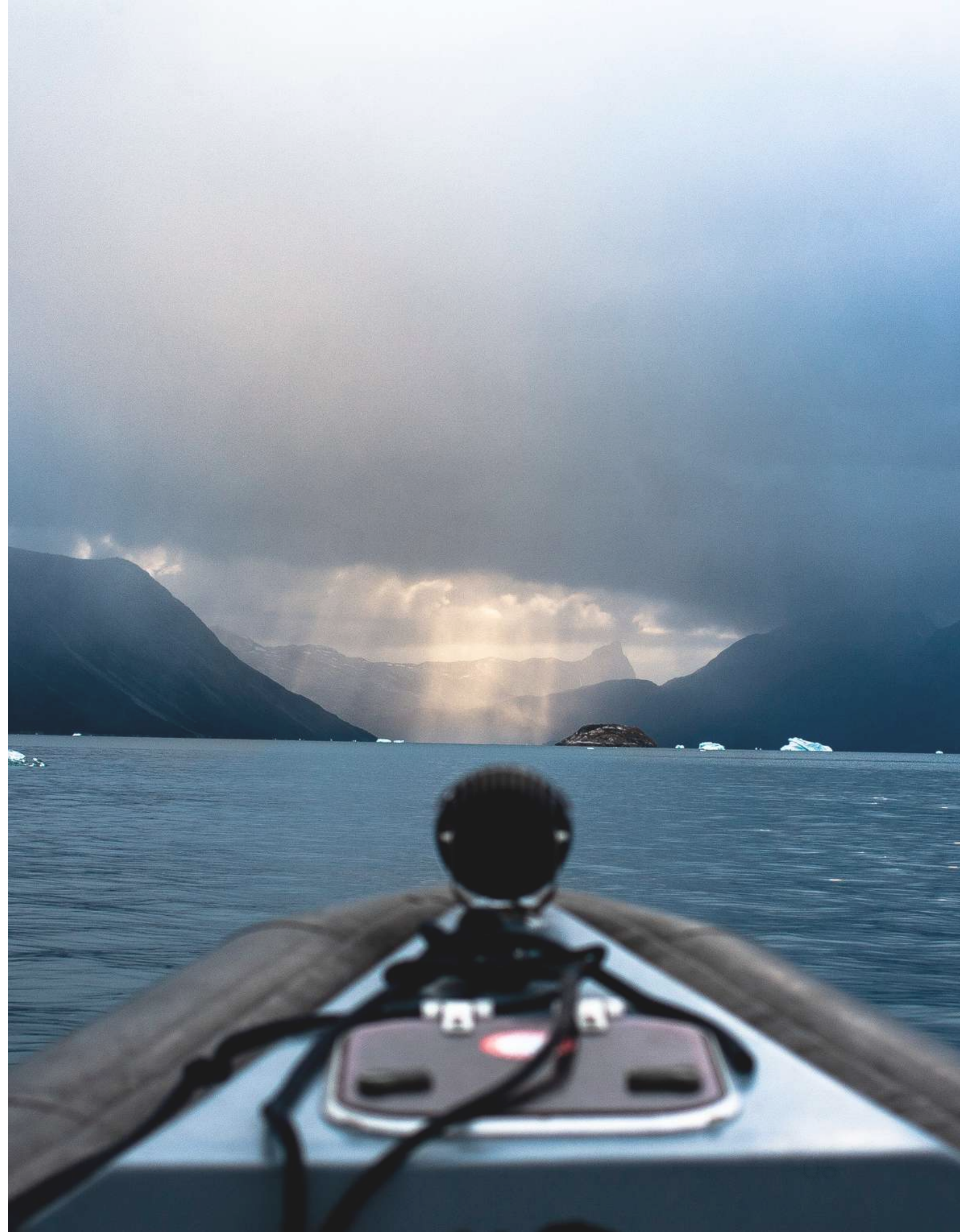

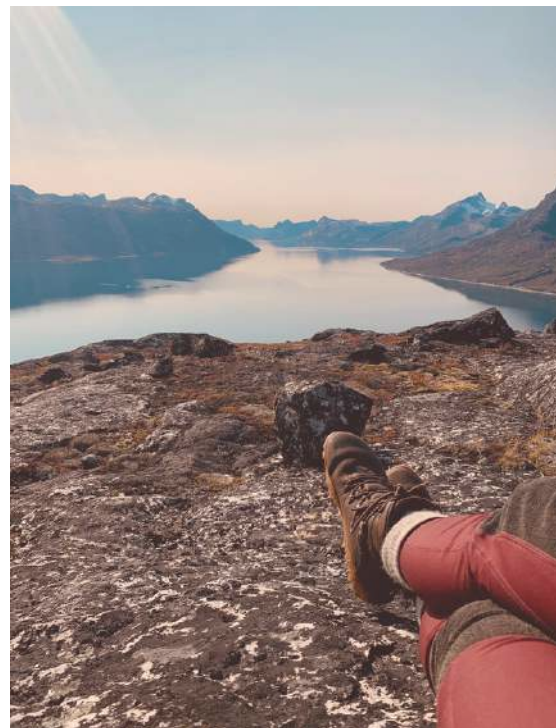
Icy Exploration of Narsap Sermia Fjord
